



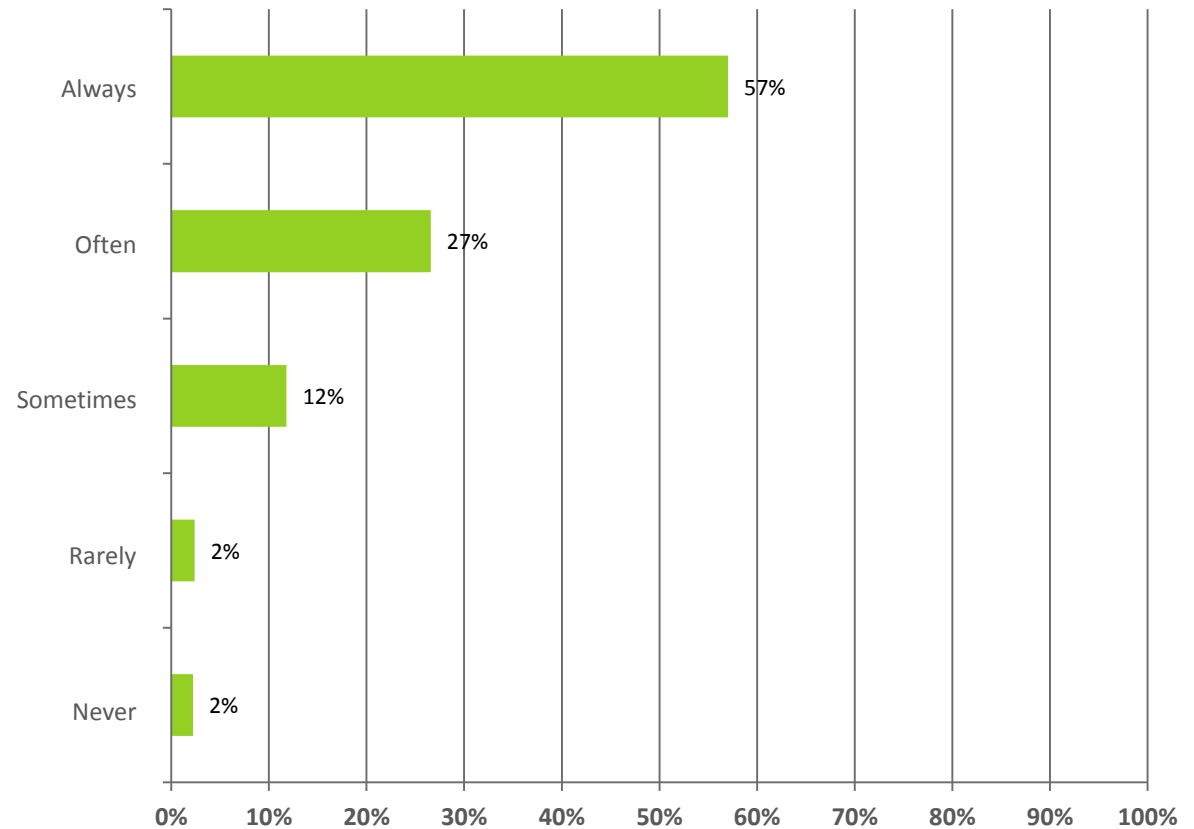

QBC_Q1. How often, if at all, do you re-use plastic carrier bags for shopping, as bin liners, or for other uses around the home?

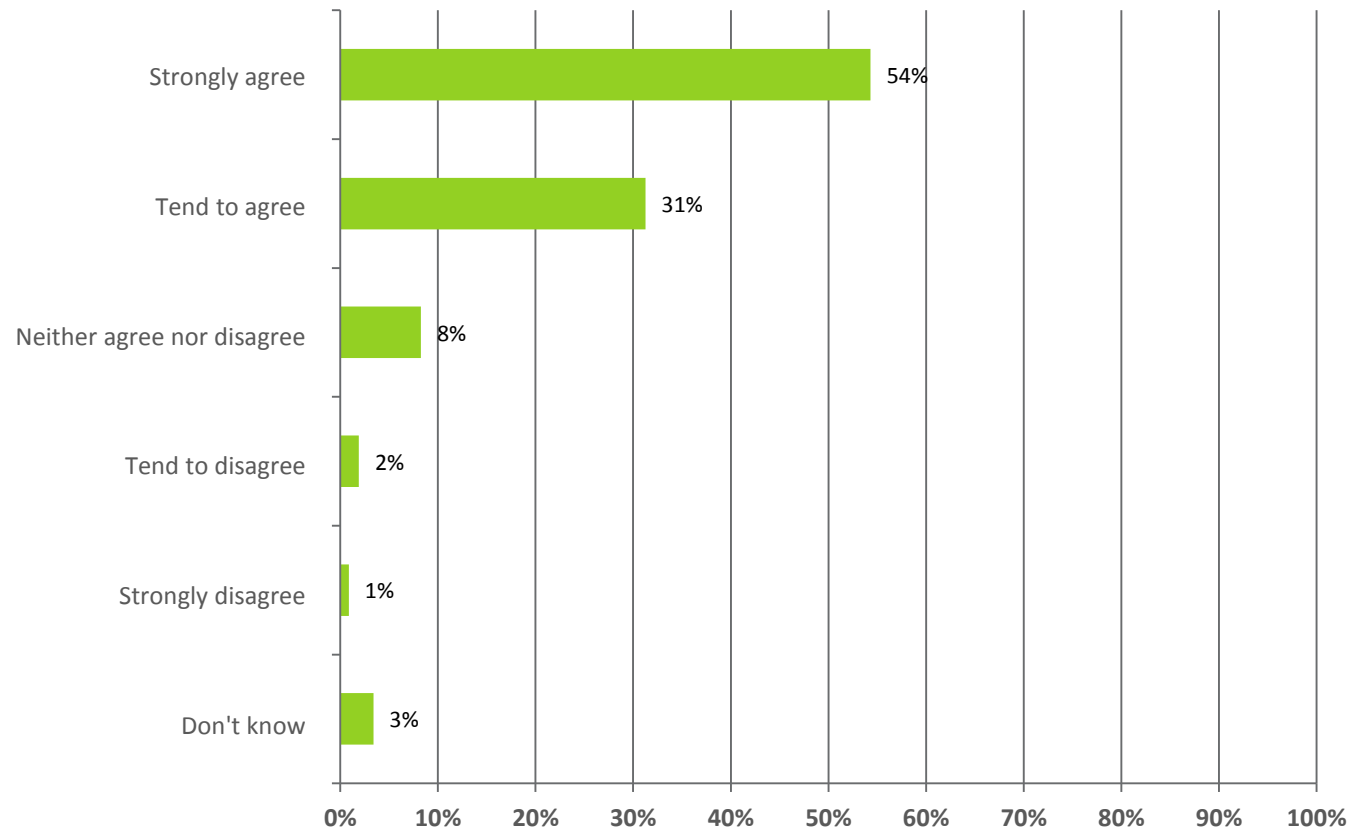

QBC_Q2. To what extent, if at all, do you agree or disagree with the following statement?

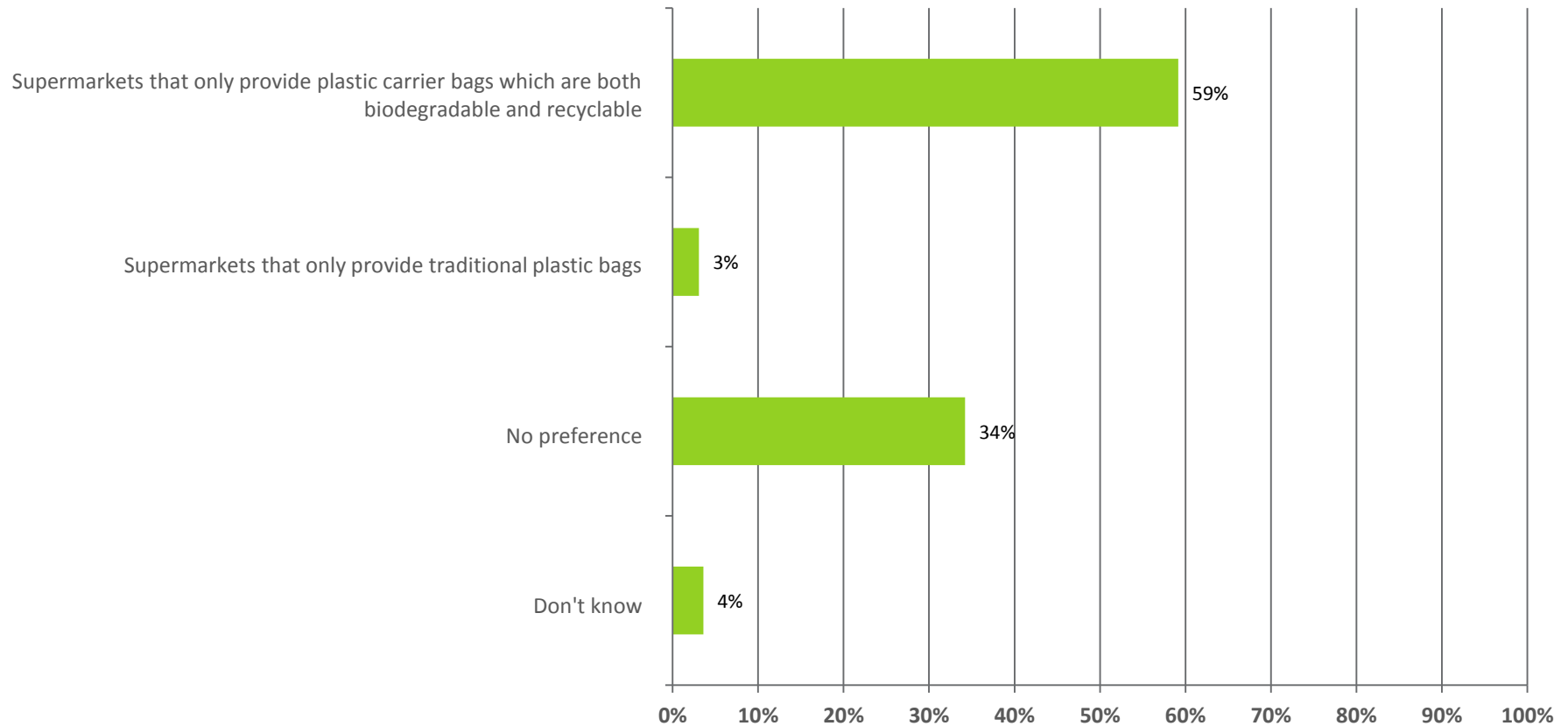
"All plastic carrier bags should be recyclable and biodegradable in case they accidentally get into the open environment"

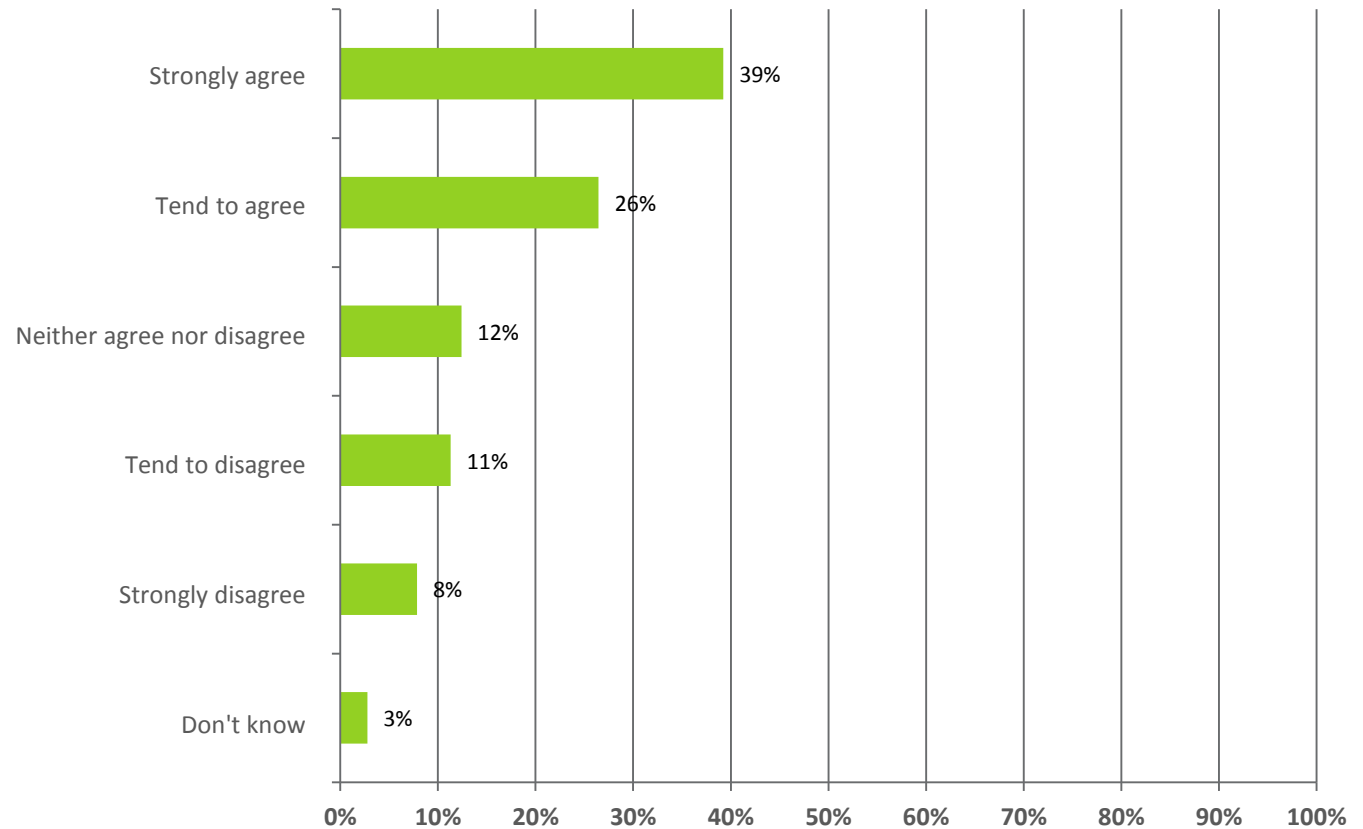
